Anne Coble Swaim, 88, died unexpectedly Wednesday, February 6, 2019 at her residence.

A funeral service will be held at Coble's Lutheran Church Sunday, February 10, 2019, at 2:00pm with the Rev. Joseph Miller officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Mrs. Swaim was a Guilford County, NC native, the daughter of Glenn and Irene M. Coble, both deceased. She attended Alamance High School, playing both basketball and softball, graduating valedictorian of the class of 1948.

Anne adapted to a variety of vocations throughout her life, early on working in purchasing with Ellis Stone, then as a homemaker, and later working as a tax consultant with H&R Block and as a bookkeeper with Strand Skees Jones & Co. She retired in 1992 from NCNB.

She was a lifelong member of Coble's Lutheran Church, serving in a variety of capacities and roles within the church. Her church family was very near and dear to her.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband of 67 years, William Douglas "Bill" Swaim, and her son-in-law, Bruce H. Bell.

Survivors include her daughter, Rev. Glynn S. Bell, son, Marcus C. Swaim (Sue), and daughter Kimberly S. Deaton (Lynn). Also surviving are her grandchildren, Shannon B. Deaton, Matthew C. Swaim, and Jacob L. Deaton (Brittney), along with a cherished great-grandchild, Isaac Lynn Deaton, and step great-grandchild, Abbi Thomas. Anne was fortunate to have numerous cousins, in-laws, and neighbors who loved much and asked little.
