Mr. Charles "Bailey" Stevens, 92, Passed away peacefully to be with the Lord on Tuesday, July 23, 2019 in his home with his family by his side.

Bailey was born on September 17, 1926 in Stokes County to the late Newton A. and Tabitha E. Mabe Stephens. Bailey loved his family, farming, gardening, and working hard. Bailey was a charter member of First Christian Church in Walnut Cove where he served on the building committee and was of the Primitive Baptist faith. He was a retiree from RJ Reynolds Tobacco with 30 years of service and served his country proudly in the US Navy during WWII, as a member of the "Frog Team".
