MOCKSVILLE - Ms. Dorothy Elaine Jarvis Barney, 71, passed away peacefully, at home surrounded by family, Sunday, February 3, 2019.

She was born February 2, 1948, in Davie County to the late Roy and Ruby Booe Jarvis. To some, she was better known as Squeakie.

Squeakie was raised in the hardscrabble surroundings of tobacco fields throughout Davie and Yadkin Counties. This determination to see things grow bore out in her home gardening and later career of nurturing hundreds of young children in North Carolina's initial testing of an in-school pre-kindergarten program at William R. Davie Elementary School. She would work extensively with a wide range of children and eventually retire from the mature version of the experiment at Central Davie with twenty years of service. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Edward. Survivors include two sons, Jeff Barney (Amanda) and P.J. Barney; and two grandchildren, Shea and Creighton.

A graveside service will be conducted at 3 p.m., Wednesday, February 6, at Liberty Baptist Church with Dr. David Gilbreath officiating. Interment will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends from 1:30 to 2:30 p.m., Wednesday at the church.
