Fred Leon Allen, 95, of Greensboro passed away peacefully on January 23, 2020 surrounded by family.

Fred spent time in service to his country in the Army Air Corps and was a veteran of the Korean War. After leaving the Army, he continued by serving his community with the Greensboro Police Reserve.
