Mr. Larry Everette King, 83, of Greensboro, passed away Friday, February 1, 2019 at Kerner Ridge Assisted Living, in Kernersville.

The funeral service will be held Saturday, February 9, 2019, at 2:00 p.m., at Magnolia Street Baptist Church of Greensboro. Interment will follow at Guilford Memorial Park in Jamestown.

Mr. King was born in Charlotte, NC on April 25, 1935 to the late John Paul King and Gladys Lumley King. He graduated from Greensboro High School and later from Guilford College with a B.S. in mathematics. Larry worked for many engineering firms in Greensboro, but found joy for many years with Burlington Industries.
