



Lois Cameron Shore

September 25, 1921 - February 3, 2019

MOCKSVILLE - Mrs. Lois Cameron Shore, 97, formerly of 190 W. Church Street, Mocksville, died Sunday, February 3, 2019, in Midlothian, VA.

She was born in Alabama to the late Preston Leard and Lethye Woods Cameron. Tom Shore met Lois on a blind date during his military training in Mobile, AL. At the end of World War II, they wed, and Tom brought her to Davie County. Shortly after that they moved into the house where they lived until his death and she remained until 2011. Lois became an active part of the Mocksville community. She was a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Mocksville where she served in a number of capacities. She worked at the Bank of Davie, as a teacher's aide at Mocksville Elementary School, as secretary at First Baptist Church, and spent most of her working years as the secretary to the branch manager at Central Carolina Bank. She also served the community, chairing the board of Davie County Hospital and serving on the Mocksville Zoning Board and the board of Mocksville Savings Bank.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 60 years, Thomas Isaac Shore.

Surviving are two daughters, Kathy (Steve) Allsbrook and Jane (Ed) Burkhart; four grandchildren, David (Julie) Allsbrook, Jonathan Rivers, Kelly (Bill) Hartland, and Rebecca Rivers; nine great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

A graveside service will be conducted at 11 a.m., Saturday, February 9, at Rose Cemetery.
