



## Roy Pason Ingle III

December 6, 1963 - September 29, 2021

Pason "Hotshot" / "Papey" Ingle III, age 57, passed away peacefully at home on Wednesday, September 29, 2021.

Pason was a Greensboro native and the son of Roy Pason Ingle Jr and Carol Sutphin Tatum. He graduated from Grimsley High School 1981 and took classes at GTCC for computer programming in 1990. Pason worked at several companies, including Teva and Ralph Lauren, but had the longest career and retired from Procter & Gamble.

Pason loved the Lord and his faith was a central part of his life, which he did not hesitate to share with others, especially the Hebraic roots of his faith in Jesus (Yeshua). Pason was one of the most knowledgeable people I have ever known and he shared that knowledge to teach and encourage others in a multitude of ways.
